Scene 2

Kerry: Yes!!! I'm so glad it's Saturday, my favorite day of the whole week!

Sherry: Me too! Finally a day off!

Steve: A day to do what ever I want to do!

Kent: Close the drapes I'm trying to get some sleep here!

Sherry: Come on Kent, get up! This is the day we've been waiting for a whole week!

Steve: Seems more like a month! When I'm president there's going to be six Saturdays a week and no Mondays at all!

Gary: (to the audience with disgust) Politician! . . . Come on let's get ready for football practice!

Karen: No way! I'm heading to the shopping mall.

Kevin: I want to go to the park

Joanie: I'm spending my day at the library.

Judy: (pushing through everybody) Out of my way everybody! I have got to get to a phone!

Sherry: Come on Kent! Get up! Today is the day of your piano lesson.

Kent: (sits up from his bed and does a scream with hands on his face) AHHHH!

Sherry: That piano teacher scares me too. Maybe the new one will be better.

Steve: Or maybe Mom will forget?

All: (looking hopeful and then shaking their heads) Nah!

Judy: (Yelling) Quiet! (softly now) I'm on the phone.

Kerry: Well no matter what, if it is Saturday, I'm starting off this day like any Red-blooded American kid ought to

All: Cartoons! Yeah!!!

SONG: TOON TIME

Scene 3

Judy: (on the phone) I don't know, Bonnie. Do you really think that we can ignore the social ramifications of a Pebbles and Bam Bam split? Oh . . . could you hold for a second? I've got a call on the other line. (Switches lines) Oh, hi Penny. We were just talking about the plans for the . . . (fades out).

Debbie: Oh there's so much to do today. I just don't know where to start.

All: (everybody starts talking about their plans at once) I'm going to play football. I'm going skating. Let's hit the mall!

Kent: Well, you all can spend your day doing all of that running and playing and practicing and carrying on if you want to. But I've got a much better way to spend my Saturday than that! I've got plans big plans.

Sherry: What's that Kent? What are you going to do on your day off?

Kent: (very slowly) Absolutely, positively, with my whole heart. nothing! (big grin to the audience)

SONG: TIME TO SPARE

Scene 4

Kerry: Well have a good day off Kent, and don't strain yourself on that easy chair. The rest of us have got to get going.

All: Yeah! Let's go!

Steve: Who's got the football?

Kevin: I hope I have enough money for the matinee.

Karen: All I need is my credit card.

(cast continues talking as they walk toward the door. Mother's voice is heard from off stage and they freeze in their tracks)

Mother: (off stage) Hold everything! Where do you think you're going?

Jeffrey: Mom's up.

Mother: You know that your new piano teacher is coming today. He's from the conservatory.

All: (very impressed) OOOOOO the conservatory!

Jeffrey: He's got to be better than that last lady with the yardstick. My knuckles are still sore. (everyone rubs knuckles)

Mother: (off stage, very sweetly) How I wish that I would have had the privilege of piano lessons when I was a child. (now like a drill sergeant) NOW GET OVER TO THAT PIECE OF FURNITURE AND PRACTICE!

All: (resigned) Yes mother.

SONG: BOOGIE WOOGIE PIANO TEACHING MAN

Script in song

Piano Man: Is everybody happy?

3rd grade singers: Yea

Piano Man: Are we going to boogie or what?

3rd Grade Singers: What?!

Piano Man: Now, if we're going to boogie with real woogie we've got to do a little warm up! Are you ready?!

3rd Grade Singers: Yea!

Piano Man: Gooooood! So, everybody raise your left hand and shake it in the air! That's it! Now . . . add the right hand if you've got what it takes . . . now, rock it!!! I said . . . ROCK IT!

3rd Grade Singers: Yea

Piano Man: Now think Boogie

3rd Grade Singers: Boogie

Piano Man: Now think Woogie

3rd Grade Singers: Woogie

Piano Man: Now do the BOOGIE WOOGIE!!!!!!

3rd Grade Singers: Yea

Second Verse

Piano Man: Now in order to do a proper boogie woogie you have to believe in the boogie woogie!

3rd Grade Singers: That's right, brother!

Piano Man: Do you believe brothers and sisters?

3rd Grade Singers: Yes! We believe!

Piano Man: I said do you believe brothers and sisters.

3rd Grade Singers: YES! WE BELIEVE!

Piano Man: Then put those hands on that keyboard, rock 'em back and forth, and do the boogie, oogie, woogie!!

Joanie: I....I.....I'm doing it! I'm doing it!!

Piano Man: Of course you are, baby! I'm a wonderful teacher!

Scene 5

Mother: (off stage) O.K. Pick it up! Pick it up! Move those feet! Work those knees! You ate it, you lift it! Let's go! Let's Go! WIND SPRINTS!!!!!!

SONG: MY MOTHER THE COACH

script during song

Mother: (during song) You call yourself a football team. You look like a bunch of marshmallows to me! I've seen marching bands that can tackle better than that! Chest up! Shoulders down! Stomach in! CLEAN???? You call that uniform clean???? There've been a few slackers around here! I wanna see some sweat!

Scene 6

(The entire cast is exhausted from football practice.)

Kerry: That lady is out of control!

Dale: Oh my goodness. I think I pulled something!

Joanie: This day is almost over and we haven't even left the house!

Kent: (lazily) I know, isn't it great?

Steve: O.K. Well, let's get going.

Karen: Let's see, we've done the chores . . .

Kevin: Check

Kent: We've had our piano lesson . . .

All: AHHHH!

Sherry: We've even had football practice (everyone rubs muscles and groans)

Kent: Body check

Judy: (on the phone) And that's all I have to say about that! (hangs up)

Gary: And Judy's even off the phone. (everybody applauds)

Kerry: Chores, piano lessons, football practice . . . now let's go!

(cast starts heading toward the door, door bell rings)

Kent: Get that! It might be the door.

(One person opens the door and several students enter carrying supplies for a slumber party.)

Kathy: We're here for the slumber party.

Kent: Slumber party? Now we're talkin'!

All: Slumber party?? All right!!!!

(other students enter with pillows and blankets for the party. "lights" go out and all the characters are sleeping. All characters stay on stage.)

Scene 7

(all are sleeping just like the beginning of the show. Alarm rings.)

Kid 1: Oh no! It can't be time to get up already!

Kid 2: It can't be time to get up! I didn't get my twelve hours!

Kent: Close those drapes. I'm trying to get some sleep here!

Kid 3: Where am I? Where am I?

Kid 4: I'm gonna get that rooster if it's the last thing I do!

Judy: (into phone) Hello? Hello?

Steve: hey do you think it could be Saturday again today?

Gary: Are you the President yet?

Steve: No I guess it couldn't be, could it?

Joanie: How are we ever going to make it through another week?

Sherry: Well, I know how I'm going to get through today at least.

Karen: How's that Sherry?

Sherry: I'm just going to keep telling myself that in just six more days it's going to be Saturday all over again!

All: Yeah!
